



Phase III of the NNRCMP started in April 2021

In the previous phase, the SERCMP collected:

40,000 topographic beach profiles, and expanded use of UAVs

1873km² Lidar (every 2 years, alternating East and West)

3830km² Aerial Photography (2016, 2019/20)

Habitat Mapping of 2019/20 aerials

National Bathymetry: 390km coastline (we're up to 69% of the white ribbon); Norbit Trials

500,000 hours of wave data, and a new Rye Wave Buoy

Website hits averaging 6 million visits every month, £277 Million worth of downloads;
288,301 individual downloads
